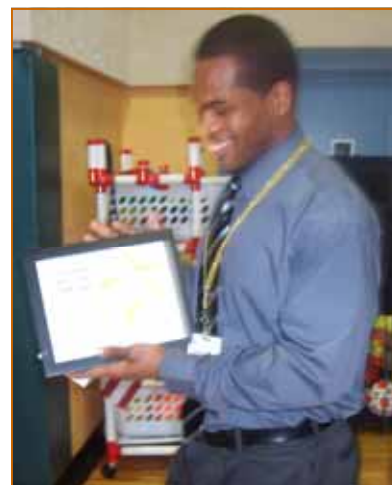


### February Proactivity Winners
