PROACTIVITY AWARDS

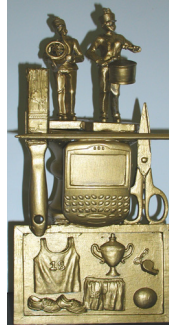
